

RESOLUTION NO. 70-42

A RESOLUTION AGREEING TO RECOGNIZE AND EVALUATE FLOOD HAZARDS IN THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AND AGREEING TO MAKE CONTROL MEASURES CONSISTENT WITH THE NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM AND CARRYING OUT THE OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of The City of Key West, Florida, by Resolution No. 70-41, dated May 18, 1970, has previously recognized the public need for flood insurance, and expressed a positive interest in the Flood Insurance Program, and desires to take such official action as may be necessary to comply with the criteria of said Program, and to assure the Department of Housing and Urban Development of its intention to comply with the regulations established by said Department, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of The City of Key West, Florida, as follows:

1. That said City Commission will recognize and evaluate flood hazards in all actions relating to land use in the flood plain areas in The City of Key West, Florida, having special flood hazards.
2. That said City Commission will enact by December 31, 1971, and maintain in force for the areas having special flood hazards, adequate land use and control measures with effective enforcement provisions consistent with the National Flood Insurance Program criteria
3. That said City Commission will continue to cooperate with neighboring jurisdictions with respect to adjoining drainage areas and flood plains in order to prevent the aggravation of the flooding problem.
4. That said City Commission will take such other official action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objectives of the program.
5. That said City Commission hereby appoints the City Manager as the official of The City of Key West, Florida, with the responsibility, authority and means to implement the commitments made herein, and hereby designates the office of the said City


Manager in the City Hall, Key West, Florida, as the location where copies of the official maps and rate tables can be made available for public inspection.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by said Commission that the City Clerk of said City Commission be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to forward certified copies of this Resolution to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for appropriate action.
