

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

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

This project consisted of replacing the stormwater drainage system within the Sunset Circle area to alleviate localized flooding due to improperly sized conveyances and/or damaged conveyances. The existing drainage system for this 17 acre basin was installed in the 1950's and consisted of a series of inlets, pipes, and swales. Storms from the 2005 hurricane season created damage throughout the sub-surface infrastructure.

A stormwater analysis of the project area was performed to identify the deficient areas and to design improvements. Improvements included new inlets, headwalls, 3,200 LF of pipe (ranging from 12" to 30"), and re-grading of swales.
