Public Transportation:

Regular City Bus Services - Fantasy Fest Week (10/22/10 – 10/31/10)

- Road closures will begin the weekend of Goombay Festival, 10/22 and 10/23 - which will cause delays and detours to regular bus services, scheduled pick-up points and times.
- Buses will not provide service west of Simonton Street on Friday 10/22, 10/29; nor Saturday 10/23, 10/30/2010. Regular bus service will resume Sunday, 10/24 and 10/31/2010.
- Events planned throughout the week may prevent buses from servicing stops west of Simonton Street - updated information will be posted on the City's website at www.keywestcity.com and on the City's Real Time Passenger Information System at www.kwtransit.com or call (305) 600-1455.
- On Saturday 10/30/10, regular bus service will operate until 4:59 pm, at which time all City and Lower Keys bus service will convert to FREE Captain Morgan SAFE RIDE shuttles for the parade event.

FREE Captain Morgan "SAFE RIDE" Shuttles:

- The City of Key West Department of Transportation is pleased to announce the return of the **FREE Captain Morgan SAFE RIDE shuttle bus** service for the **2010** annual parade event.
- **FREE** Shuttles will operate on **Saturday 10/30/10** between **5:00 pm** and **2:00 am**. Shuttles end at 2:00 am - this includes travel time.
- **Lower Keys** shuttles must depart Key West no later than **12:30 am** (after **midnight**) for return trips to Marathon. Plan ahead, seating is limited on the last bus out!
- **City bus shuttles** will have a final pick up call at **1:45 am**.
- The designated drop off / pick up point for the FREE shuttles is Fausto's on Fleming and Bahama Streets. Plan your return trip in advance as seating capacities are limited on all vehicles.
- All buses will travel clockwise and counter-clockwise in Key West and Stock Island - with Keys shuttles rotating between Key West and Marathon as traffic permits. Additional information will be available at www.keywestcity.com and at www.kwtransit.com.
- **Official Fantasy Zone Code of Conduct will be enforced. Nudity is illegal – AND NOT allowed on public property or in public view. Body paint does not constitute clothing – cover up!**

Municipal Parking:

The City operates three (3) municipal parking lots at the following locations and the following rates:

1) Old Town Garage (Park N' Ride)	\$2.00 / hr or \$13 / day
2) Mallory Square	\$4.00 / hr or \$32 / day
3) Key West Bight	\$2.50 / hr or \$16.25 / day

NOTE: (special event rates may apply during street fair and parade events.)

Oversized Vehicle Information (RV's, Tour Buses, Motor Homes, Other):

Please be aware that City Ordinances **prohibit parking of oversized vehicles** within the City. Passenger drop off and pick up sites are designated on the East side of the island up to and including White Street. Read below for oversize vehicle accommodations.

Key West High School – Fees & Services

Parking ONLY - The City refers oversized vehicles to the Key West High School, at 2100 Flagler Avenue. Parking is available Friday 10/29/10, beginning at 6:00pm and Saturday 10/30/10, beginning at 8:00 am, with the rates as follows: Rates are based on a 24-hour maximum period.

- \$25 (RV's / Motor homes) Please pre-register these vehicles
- \$30 (Tour Buses / Buses) Please pre-register these vehicles
- \$10 (All Other Vehicles)

Shuttles TOO! - Shuttle services at the Key West High School will kick off at 12:00 pm (noon) on Saturday, 10/30/10. The fee is \$5 / person / trip - shuttles end at 12:01 am (midnight).
