

**Duval Street Committee Meeting Minutes**  
**September 3, 2008**

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m.

Chairman Jimmy Weekley indicated seeing no corrections to the minutes of August 13, 2008 and August 27, 2008 the minutes are accepted as written.

Chairman Weekley briefed the attendee on the Luncheon held at La Te Da that was held on August 27<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Weekley mentioned that there were more participants at the luncheon. Mr. Weekley mentioned that Francine Bolduc agreed to take the lead for the street closure. Mr. Weekley stated that one of the things that was talked about was what to name the street closure.

LJ Cicero mentioned that Francine Bolduc is putting together a questionnaire in order to get some feedback from the merchants that will participate.

Chairman Weekley stated that at this point the Duval Street Committee's purpose is to work with the businesses and jump any hurdles with the City of Key West.

Chairman Weekley mentioned that the street closure would not need City staff to come and put the no parking signs up or to close the street. Mr. Weekley suggested that the merchants in the street closure corridor could manage those tasks.

Chairman Weekley stated that he would be attending the Special Events Workshop and will voice the Duval Street Committees concern and again remind them what it is that the Committee is trying to accomplish.

LJ Cicero reported that she spoke with Shawn Smith, City Attorney about her progress in reference to the liability insurance. Ms. Cicero mentioned that the merchants that are planning in participating agreed in making the City of Key West an additional insured on their liability insurance.

Chairman Weekley suggested that somehow combine the sidewalk café and art the concept/name for the street closure.

Chairman Weekley asked Vivian Perez to notify Mr. Smith that the dates of the street closures have changed and that they are now Saturday, November 1, 8, 15, 22, and 29; Saturday, December 13, 20, and 27, 2008.

Roger McVeigh suggested that the merchant could come up with a nominal fee (nothing large) and use that for marketing/advertising.

The next meeting was set for Wednesday, September 10, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. at 525 Angela Street in the ADA Conference Room.

The meeting ended at 9:45 a.m.
