

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA,
ADOPTING AN AD VALOREM TAX GENERAL MUNICIPAL
MILLAGE RATE FOR FY 2009-2010; PROVIDING FOR
SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF
INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the final adopted ad valorem tax general municipal millage rate for FY 2009-2010 is hereby set at ~~2.7603~~ ~~2.7074~~ 2.6414 mills (~~\$2.7603~~ ~~2.7074~~ 2.6414 per thousand dollars of assessed property value). The 2009-2010 final adopted millage rate is ~~4.5~~ ~~2.5~~ 0 percent greater than the 2009-2010 rolled back rate of 2.6414 mills.*

(Coding: Added language at first reading is underlined; language deleted at first reading is ~~struck through~~; final language added at second reading is underlined twice; language deleted at second reading is ~~struck through twice~~)

Section 2: That this Ordinance is adopted in accordance with Chapter 200.065, Florida Statutes.

Section 3: If any section, provision, clause, phrase, or application of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable

therefrom and shall be construed as reasonable and necessary to achieve the lawful purposes of this Ordinance.

Section 4: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of said City in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby superseded to the extent of such conflict.


Section 5. This Ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
