

## Transportation and Parking Information - Fantasy Fest 2014

The City of Key West Department of Transportation invites party goers to Park and Ride with Us - for a safe and responsible Fantasy Fest 2014...



### Public Transportation: Regular Bus Services - Fantasy Fest Week (10/17/14 – 10/26/14)

- Road closures will begin the weekend of Goombay Festival, 10/18 and 10/19 - which will cause delays and detours to regular bus services, scheduled pick-up points and times.
- Buses will **NOT** provide service west of Simonton Street on Friday and Saturday (Goombay and Fantasy Fest Fair / Parade events on both weekends) which will be 10/17, 10/18, 10/24 and 10/25/2014.
- Regular bus service will resume Sunday morning, both weeks, on 10/19 and 10/26/2014. Note that events planned throughout the week may prevent buses from servicing stops west of Simonton Street - updated information will be posted on the City's website at [www.keywestcity.com](http://www.keywestcity.com) and on the City's Real Time Passenger Information System at [www.kwtransit.com](http://www.kwtransit.com) or by calling (305) 600-1455.
- On Saturday 10/25/14, regular bus service will operate until 4:59 pm, at which time all City and Lower Keys bus service will convert to SAFE RIDE shuttles for the parade event. Please note that there will be a short service interruption while buses change shifts; please plan accordingly.

### “SAFE RIDE” Shuttles:

- Shuttles will operate on **Saturday 10/25/2014** between **5:00 pm** and **2:00 am**. Shuttles end at 2:00 am – *with the last trip from Key West to Marathon departing Fausto's at 12:30 am.*
- **Lower Keys shuttles will depart Key West no later than 12:30 am** (after midnight) for return trips to Marathon. Plan ahead, seating is limited on the last bus out! Fare is **\$ 4.00 / person / trip each way. (Exact change required – drivers do not make change.)**
- **City bus shuttles will have a final pick up call at 1:45 am.** Fare is **\$ 2.00 / person / trip each way. (Exact change each way – drivers do not make change.)**
- The designated drop off / pick up point for the shuttles is Fausto's on Fleming and Bahama Streets.
- All buses will travel clockwise & counter-clockwise in Key West & Stock Island - with Keys shuttles rotating between Key West and Marathon as traffic permits. - Official Fantasy Zone Code of Conduct will be enforced. **Nudity is illegal – AND NOT allowed on public property or in public view.** Body paint does not constitute clothing – bring a cover up!

### Municipal Parking:

The City operates three (3) municipal parking lots at the following locations and the following rates

1) Park N' Ride (Old Town Garage)	\$30.00 / flat rate (10/24 and 10/25)
2) Mallory Square	\$4.00 / hr or \$32 / day
3) Key West Bight	\$2.50 / hr or \$16.25 / day

NOTE: (PNR rate reflects the special event rate)

Tour buses and other oversized vehicles may drop off passengers and park at Truman Waterfront on Saturday, 10-25, from 11:00 am to 3:00 am for \$100. Once parked, vehicles will not be allowed to exit until parade ends around 11:00 pm. Buses may also drop off passengers in 600 block of Simonton, corner of Southard, but must immediately leave the historic district.

#### **Key West High School (Senior Class and Girls' Softball Team Fundraiser Events)**

**Parking:** - The City refers oversized vehicles to the Key West High School, at 2100 Flagler Avenue. Parking is available Friday 10/24/14 5:00 pm to 10:00 pm and Saturday 10/25/14, 11:00 am to 8:00 pm with the rates as follows:

- \$40 with Reservation, \$70 / \$100 without reservation (RV's / Motor homes / Buses & Other Oversized Vehicles). Reservations REQUIRED in advance for Friday parking.
- \$25 (All Other Vehicles)

Rates are based on a 24-hour maximum period.

**Shuttles TOO!** Shuttle bus service from the High School to Simonton Street (at Southard and Fausto's) will be available from 1:00 pm to 8:00 pm on Saturday. Fee is \$ 2 / person (per trip). Call (305) 293-1549x 54339 or email [neda.preston@keysschools.com](mailto:neda.preston@keysschools.com)
