SCOPE OF WORK

The CITY is seeking BIDS from qualified individuals or firms for all materials, equipment and labor necessary for the replacement of the main fire suppression line on Wahoo Pier.

The Project will include design, materials and labor for the installation of a new main fire line for Wahoo main fixed pier. The new fire line will replace the existing fire line in its original location. Work shall include, but not be limited to:

- Removal and disposal of old main fire line on Wahoo main pier.
- Pipe materials should be H.D.P.E with heat Fusion welded joints or equivalent.
- The new fire line will incorporate three shutoff valves at three different locations to allow the fire line to be shut off at branch dock systems.
- Stainless steel hangers and fasteners will be used on the new installation of pipe.
- Sleeve all flexible pipe that may come into contact with salt water.
- Submittal of all shop drawings and permits.
- All testing and inspections.
- Provide a minimum of 2 year warranty on materials and workmanship.
- Must be designed and constructed per all applicable codes.
- The Contractor shall maintain all work areas within and outside the project boundaries free from environmental pollution, which would be in violation to any federal, state, or local regulations.

The intent of these Documents is to describe a functionally complete project (or part thereof) to be constructed in accordance with the Contract Documents. Any work, materials, or equipment that may reasonably be inferred from the Contract Documents, as being required to produce the intended result shall be supplied whether or not specifically called for.

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
