

Owner-Occupant Disclosure Statement for Electrical Permits

I understand that I as owner-occupant under city ordinance can install my own electrical system in the premise that I occupy and agree:

- A.** To obtain a permit.
- B.** To submit plans and specifications for the work to be done.
- C.** To a request to satisfy the building official that I am able and I am qualified to perform the electrical work for which I am applying.
- D.** That no work to be started until an electrical permit is obtained.
- E.** That the work is to be performed on my premise only.
- F.** To perform the electrical work according to the rules and regulations of the City's Code of Ordinance, state codes and the current National Electrical Code at the time of permitting.
- G.** To notify the building official when the work is ready for the required inspections.
- H.** To make corrections to the deficiencies as directed by the City's electrical inspector.
- I.** That, as owner-occupant, I am not allowed to pay or compensate anyone for their labor. Service of a licensed electrical contractor is allowed.
- J.** That by issuance of an electrical permit doesn't qualify me as an electrical contractor.
- K.** I will be, or the electrical contractor if so used, present for all inspections.
