Project Description:

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), at the request of the City of Key West, is conducting a corridor study along State Road (SR) A1A/South Roosevelt Boulevard from Bertha Street to Smathers Beach, in the City of Key West. The study will also take into consideration the area between Smathers Beach and SR 5/US 1/Overseas Highway.

Project Aim:

The purpose of the study is to conduct a Complete Streets evaluation of the study corridor such that the entire right-of-way is planned, designed, and operates for all modes of transportation and users. The study will evaluate the needs of vehicular and non-vehicular modes of transportation and consider options to improve/promote the aesthetics of the corridor. Public participation is encouraged to assure that the needs of the community can be appropriately addressed during this study.

Project Workshop:

A public workshop will be held from **6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, December 13, 2016 at Sheraton Suites Key West, 2001 South Roosevelt Boulevard, Key West, Florida 33040.** The meeting will follow a format that allows the public to arrive at any time from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown and City and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project, answer questions and receive comments about the study.
